## 11 Hot verbs – go and come

### Vocabulary spot

- We use *go + -ing* to talk about sports and leisure activities.  
*We go skiing every winter. Let's go shopping.*
- We use *go for a + noun* to refer to a specific occasion.  
*I'm going for a walk. Do you want to come? Let's go for a drive.*
- Go* expresses a movement away from the speaker.  
*Go away! Leave me alone. Come* expresses a movement towards the speaker.  
*Come over to my house for a barbecue.*
