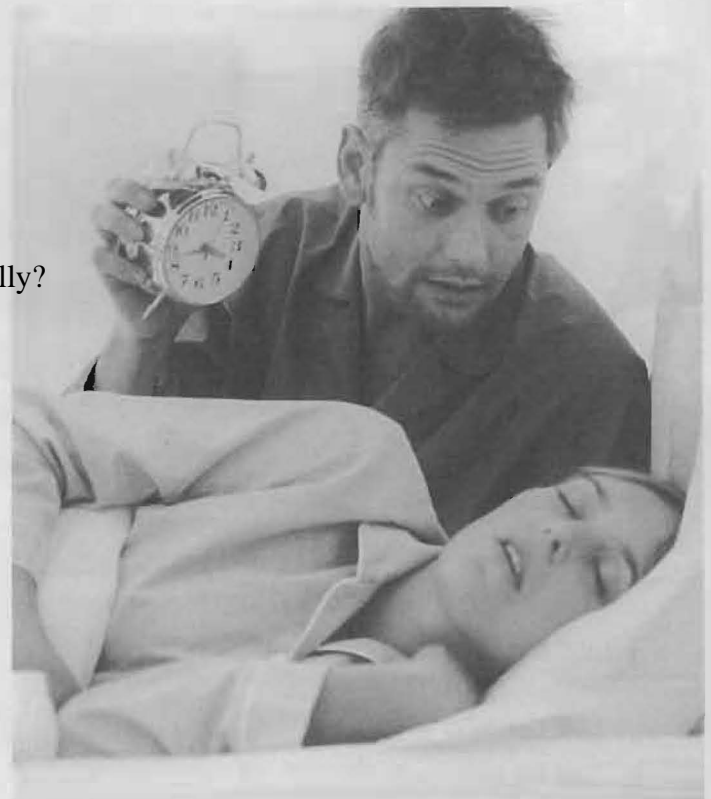
- I have to wear glasses because my eyes aren't very good.
